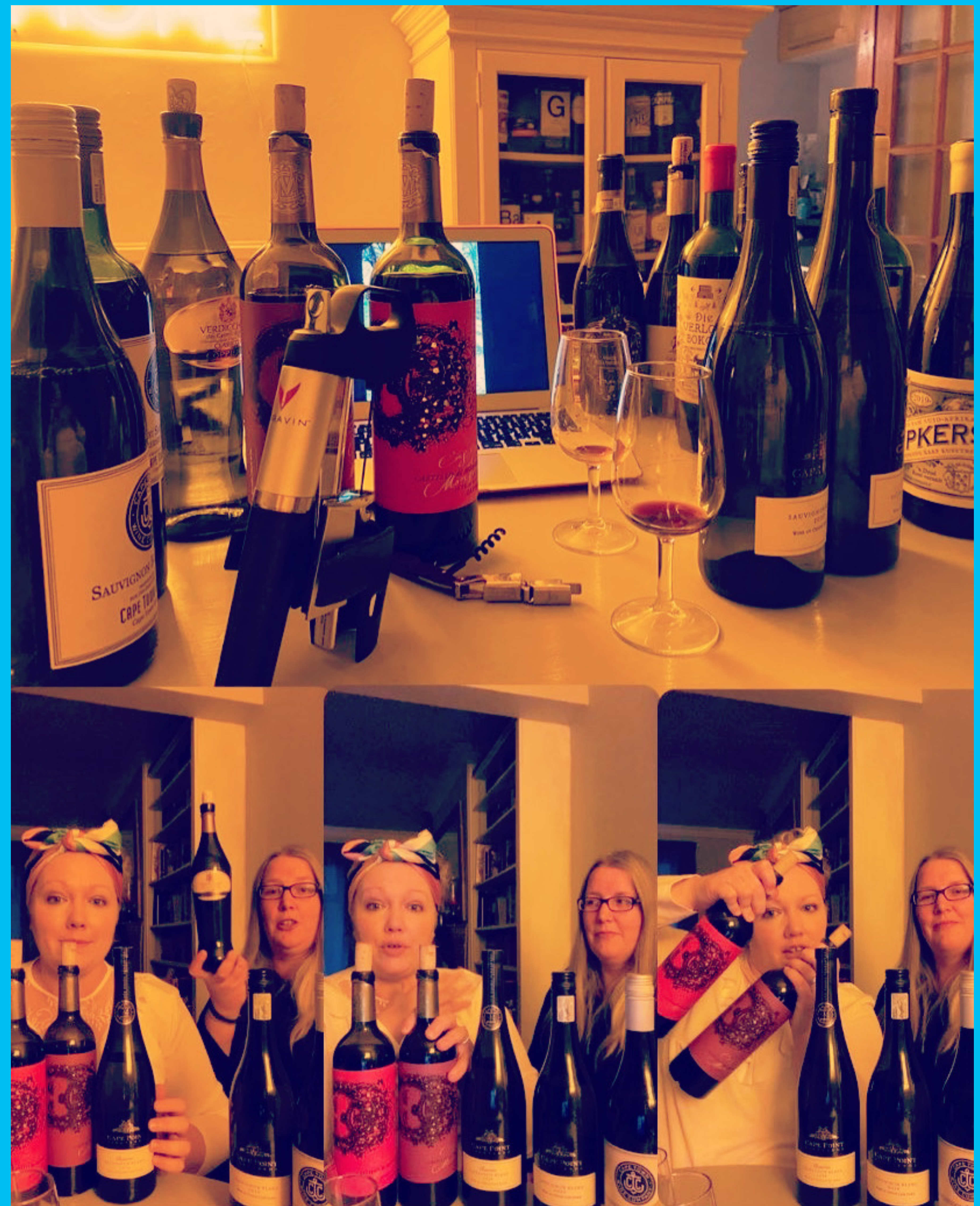

CASA DEL ARCO TINTO

VINO DE ESPAÑA, SPAIN

Simple, uncomplicated, unpretentious fruity red wine made from a field blend of traditional Spanish grape varieties harvested in the sun and transformed into a quenching beverage in the age old traditions of rural Spanish wine making. Ripe red fruits and light tannins. The perfect partner for pizza, spicy dishes like Chilli but also try it chilled with a barbecued chicken and lamb.

VIÑAMAR MERLOT

CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

From the cool climate of the Casablanca Valley, Vinamar wines are crafted by gifted young winemaker, Francesca Perazzo. It's a lightly spiced wine and packed with dark fruit, particularly blackberries and plums. Ideal to pair with beef, lamb, pork, duck, cheeses, pasta and pizza

LAS CONDES CARMÉNÈRE

CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

This is a cheeky little Carménère that pairs so well with comfort food. Something we all need right now. It's got lots of black hedgerow fruit on the palate and some lovely little spicy notes that play on your tongue. Carménère is really what the Chileans do best; it's their grape (although for years they thought it was Merlot!!) It's a grape style that offers fruit and spice in balanced proportions.

MANZANOS PEGASO VIÑAS VIEJAS GARNACHA

NAVARRA, SPAIN

On the border between Rioja and Navarra, Victor Manzanos carries on the work of the four generations before him. Adding in significant amounts of ambition and energy, Victor Manzanos is at the forefront of the new Rioja - championing a modern interpretation of its varieties through his wines. This wine stands out for its aromas of black fruit, ripe red fruits and violets. Well structured, round and mellow.

LA PLACE MERLOT

IGP PAYS D'OC, FRANCE

The vineyards are located close to the historic medieval city of Carcassonne on gently sloping, South West facing hills. Soft and elegant with ripe damson fruit character, subtle tannin and a long elegant finish. This very accessible juicy Merlot would be ideal with lamb, Turkey or Country ham and would compliment herbed or cream sauces. Lemon zest and caper dressings would also work well.

BORGIO SENA MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO

TUSCANY, ITALY

A classic, plum-filled Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, pleasantly scented with violets, peonies and more plums. Deliciously smooth with subtle spice and perfect for simple tomato based Italian food.

LA CADENCE BLANC DE BLANCS VIN DE FRANCE

Based in the Languedoc-Roussillon region. A delicious blend of Vermentino, Grenache Blanc, Ugni Blanc & Colombard. red apple, stone fruit and floral aromas with rounded flavours of melon, peach and apple on the palate. Soft in texture with a persistent finish. Try with haddock fish cakes or fried whitebait. Equally, a great little aperitif!

PIERRE ET PAPA BLANC IGP COMTÉ TOLOSAN, FRANCE

Inspired by the fanciful tales of Pierre Renard and his father, Pierre et Papa's nostalgic feel is very much in tune with the desire to seek out honest value. From approximately 20 year old vines from vines planted at around 4,000 vines per ha on selected plots on clay and limestone soils in the area of Comté Tolosan around Toulouse in Gascony. This area benefits hugely from the influence of the Atlantic; Crisp and lively with an abundance of peach, honey, apple and tangy citrus fruit on the palate.

TRAPICHE 'MELODIAS' PINOT GRIGIO MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

Gently citrusy Pinot Grigio from Argentina, brimming with peach and apricot and finishing with a twist of orange peel and a sprinkling of spice. Selected vineyards in the high area of the Mendoza River and in the East region of the Province of Mendoza. Enjoy as an aperitif or served with salads, seafood, tapas, light pastas and poultry.

LAS CONDES CHARDONNAY CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

Made by Santa Carolina, founded in 1922 in Santiago and are one of the oldest wine producers in Chile, this wine has a fruity nose with fresh pineapple and banana fruit. On the palate, the tropical fruit is met by a smooth, creamy mouth-feel and balancing acidity. Simple poultry dishes go really well with it...

VIÑAMAR SAUVIGNON BLANC CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

From the cool climate of the Casablanca Valley, Vinamar wines are crafted by gifted young winemaker, Francesca Perazzo. The cool nights mean that grapes ripen perfectly and arrive at the winery in pristine condition ready to be transformed into these fantastic easy drinking styles. Intensely aromatic Chilean Sauvignon Blanc, following up herbal notes with a rounded, tropical flavour of pineapple and mango.

CIELO GARGANEGA CHARDONNAY VENETO, ITALY

A family winery since 1908, Cielo craft Italian wines that reflect simplicity and are very quaffable. Ripe aromas of melon and peach with subtle floral notes. Enjoy by itself.

DAVINCI BRUNITO TOSCANA TUSCANY, ITALY

Montalcino, an ancient and fascinating Sienese village of Etruscan origin, lies amongst a forest of oak trees at an altitude of 600m. On a hill at the border of this region, named Poggio del Sasso – or ‘pebbles peak’ – Sangiovese grapes perform particularly well for the winegrowers of Da Vinci, and nowhere is it better exemplified than in their Brunito Rosso. A Tuscan red packed with cherries and raspberries, finishing with a perfumed note of spice. Try a venison pie with dried cranberries, or a duck ragu with five spice.

HESKETH ‘MIDDAY SOMEWHERE’ SHIRAZ LIMESTONE COAST, AUSTRALIA

The Hesketh Wine Company is a small, family owned producer of high quality. Each wine is either made from a single vineyard or sourced from a small selection of specific vineyards in each region. Made in a medium-bodied style, this wine shows bright primary fruit flavours with spice, and natural acidity. The nose is lifted and aromatic and when you sip, it exceeds expectations; so much so that you may find it hard to resist. And why would you? After all, it’s Middy Somewhere....

VIÑA INDOMITA NOSTROS PINOT NOIR RESERVA CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

What makes Indomita stand out is the way they strive to achieve excellence with some of the best winemakers in Chile and an incredible state of the art winery in Casablanca. ‘This Pinot has gentle loganberry and black plum fruit, a lush, almost fat, texture but its beautifully balanced and an exotic scent of eucalyptus.’ Oz Clarke

MAISON SINNAE ‘ELEMENTS TERRA’ CÔTES DU RHÔNE RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE

Situated on the right bank of the Rhône, Maison Sinnae grew up on the plateau dominating the villages of Laudun and Chusclan. It was there that the Romans began to spread the culture of vines and wine over two thousand years ago: at Caesar’s Camp. This wine is rich in aromas of ripe red berries which gives a full-bodied wine that promises pure indulgence on the palate. Great with lamb, curries and casseroles.

HESKETH ‘UNFINISHED BUSINESS’ PINOT NOIR LIMESTONE COAST, AUSTRALIA

Unfinished Business is a light-bodied, cool-climate Pinot Noir with pure and vibrant fruit characters. Aromatic on the nose with bright fruits of strawberry and cherries, a good acid structure, subtle savoury notes, and fine tannins provide a smooth finish.

LES MOUGEOTTES CABERNET SAUVIGNON PAYS D’OC, FRANCE

Warm, spicy Cabernet Sauvignon from southern France, perfumed with coffee and a subtle whiff of vanilla from the new oak and filling the mouth with ripe blackcurrants. It’s nectar in a glass!

LES MOUGEOTTES SAUVIGNON BLANC COLOMBARD GROS MANSENG CÔTES DE GASCogne, FRANCE

Energetic blend of tropical and citrus flavours, with lychee, mandarin and orange blossom providing fragrance while grapefruits and lemons offer a refreshing corrective. Complex and delicious by the glass but fantastic with fine flaked fish, shellfish and creamy sauces. Would also pair well with white meats that were poached or lightly fried.

FAMILLE MORIN 'CUVÉE CAROLINE' PICPOUL DE PINET LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

It was in 1966 that the Morin family took ownership of the estate. Today, Caroline Morin is the young winemaker in charge trying to express the fabulous terroir through her wines of great finesse and minerality. Very fresh aromas of white flowers, acacia and hawthorn; fresh and saline palate but with a slight roundness for a Picpoul. This is "gourmet" Picpoul.

DOMAINE DE NIZAS 'MAZET DE SALLÈLES' SAUVIGNON BLANC VIOGNIER FRANCE

Domaine de Nizas creates elegant wines which express the rich diversity of its terroir on the heights of the medieval town of Pezenas. Le Mazet de Sallèles is a blend of Sauvignon Blanc with a touch of Viognier which gives the wine an intense bouquet of mandarins, blossom and citrus notes. Its delicate acidity, roundness and lively finish make it an approachable wine for all occasions. Fresh and round, this wine will work perfectly with scallops or seafood risotto.

BODEGAS MANZANOS CASTILLO DE ENERIZ CHARDONNAY NAVARRA, SPAIN

On the border between Rioja and Navarra, Victor Manzanos carries on the work of the four generations before him. Very bright lemon colour with an intense tropical and stone fruits aroma. Fresh, with a typical silky touch on the mouth. A wine that has a beautiful silky texture and could easily lead you to believe it has had oak treatment- it has had zero!

DOÑA PAULA 'PAULA' SAUVIGNON BLANC UCO VALLEY, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

Doña Paula is a leading, modern winery at the forefront of exploring and investing in new, high quality wine regions in Argentina. This fresh, attractive Sauvignon Blanc shows intense aromas of grapefruit, lime and passion fruit that are well integrated with notes of white peach.

IL PUMO SAUVIGNON BLANC MALVASIA SALENTO, ITALY

In 1962, 19 vine growers from San Marzano whose families had farmed the land for generations, combined their efforts to establish 'Cantine San Marzano'. Floral notes combine with aromas of tropical fruits and a hint citrus zest. This lively, fresh white blend has a touch of minerality and is bursting with ripe flavours from the South of Italy.

ANGELINE PINOT NOIR CALIFORNIA, USA

A Pinot Noir with a wealth of aromas such as fresh cranberries, maraschino cherries, and orange zest. Pinot pairs so well with chicken, pork and light cheeses. Angeline Vineyards are family owned, believe in low intervention and want the terroir to shine through each bottle and to reflect the true nature of Pinot Noir.

CANTINE ASCHERI DOLCETTO D'ALBA PIEDMONT, ITALY

Silky, smooth cherry from start to finish on this flavoursome, but incredibly elegant, wine from a cooler part of Italy. Situated in the western part of the Barolo area, this estate is located partly in the municipality of La Morra and partly in the municipality of Verduno.

DOMAINE DE NIZAS 'LE CLOS' ROUGE PEZENAS, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

At the Nizas domaine, the Syrah is queen. Smooth and sensual in the mouth, it reveals intense notes of red fruits. The personality of the Syrah, at the crossroads of fruitiness and spicy, allows it to find its balance between the sweetness of the Grenache and the liveliness of the Mourvèdre.

DOMAINE LA BERTHETE 'SAINTE CECILE' CÔTES DU RHÔNE RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE

50% Grenache, 50% Syrah. Instantly appealing, perfumed, generous flavours which develop layers of complexity. Notes of liquorice & soft spice. Real finesse. Great with a pork joint, dry pork sausage and wild boar. Also medium seasoned cheeses.

SACRED HILL SYRAH RESERVE HAWKE'S BAY, NEW ZEALAND

David and Mark Mason, with friend and winemaker Tony Bish (the three renegades), kicked off the legacy of Sacred Hill back in 1986, friends and wine lovers around the world soon became a part of the magic. Classic Syrah aromas are the hallmark of this wine. White pepper, five spice and cracked espresso bean compliment dark berry fruits of boysenberry and black cherry.

CHÂTEAU MAYNE MAZEROLLES BLAYE, CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

Merlot 80%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, Malbec 10% An elegant, black fruited wine with discreet notes of spicy, vanilla oak and wild sage. Opulent and textured with fine, smooth tannins and blackberry flavours that linger on the persistent finish.

SAINT CLAIR ‘ORIGIN’ VIOGNIER

HAWKE’S BAY, NEW ZEALAND

Viognier 96%, Sauvignon Blanc 3%, Pinot Gris 1% An elegant wine displaying prominent notes of white peach, nectarine and fragrant almond blossom laced with impressions of clove and nutmeg spice. Rich and creamy on the palate through to a fresh and spicy finish. Made by a family estate that is world class.

ZEPHYR WINE SAUVIGNON BLANC

MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

Referring to himself humbly as ‘the janitor’, Ben Glover creates wines from his own vineyard in the renowned Marlborough sub-region of Dillon's Point. His whites especially deserve to be compared with other world class whites rather than merely the best of Marlborough. Dillon’s Point offers a coastal influence to this fresh, zippy Sauvignon Blanc and leaves you with a tingly and moreish saline finish.

CANTINA ANDRIANO MÜLLER-THURGAU

TRENTINO ALTO-ADIGE, ITALY

A light aromatic perfume with a gentle fragrance of tropical fruits. On the palate it's dry, medium bodied, with a fruity well-balanced acidity. This is a very elegant Northern Italian wine that oozes palate appeal and goes so well with fish, particularly swordfish.

DOMAINE DE NIZAS LANGUEDOC BLANC

PEZENAS, LANGUEDOC, FRANCE

An intense bouquet of mandarins, flowers and citrus fruits. Its acidity, roundness and lively finish make it very accessible even in its youth. The terroir of Pezenas is found in its intense nose, freshness and minerality. We tend to forget that the South of France is able to produce some of the best white wines in the country. The Herault River provides freshness to the vineyards while the altitude allows the wines to maintain a brilliant acidity. Viognier, Rolle, Roussanne blend.

MULDERBOSCH SAUVIGNON BLANC

STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA

From an iconic South African winery, this wine is unmistakably Sauvignon in character, with striking gooseberry and citrus aromas and a hint of herbal lemon-grass through to a lifted palate and a delicious, mouth-watering finish.

SILENT NOISE FIANO

MCLAREN VALE, AUSTRALIA

Joyous notes of tropical fruits rise up to greet you from the glass. Think pineapple, guava, gold kiwi fruit, strawberries and passionfruit. There is lovely palate weight and creamy texture that provides a structurally complexing character for these exotic vibrant fresh tropical flavours.
