*Crack open the bottle, pour a glass, then sit back and enjoy these irresistible easy-drinking wines from around the globe. They showcase how great wines can be at this price point from the shelves of an indie wine merchant.*

### LAS CONDES MERLOT CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

Hannah has a long relationship with this winery and has been directly importing it for years. A great little party wine which is full of fruit, but not too jammy, juicy plums and a subtle finish of spice. The ultimate easy drinking BBQ red wine that doesn't break the bank.

### CASTILLO DEL MORO TEMPRANILLO | SYRAH SPAIN

Literally meaning 'the most wanted', Vinos Más Buscados is a collection of wines grown and nurtured in the Southern half of Spain, mainly in the area known as La Mancha — a region undergoing a serious 'makeover' over the last few years. Ruby red colour with violet tints showing its youth. On the nose, it is fresh and elegant with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits typical of this variety. Light, harmonic and round on the palate with soft tannins.

### AI GALERA 'POETICO' PORTUGAL

CASTELÃO 40% | TRINCADEIRA 40% | TINTA MIÚDA 20%

Long overlooked by the wine cognoscenti, the burgeoning interest in Portuguese wine is finally resulting in more awareness of the potential of this proud country. The previously undervalued Tejo region, lying to the south of Lisbon, is capable of producing wines of enormous value and character – something that is captured by Ai Galera. Each variety is fermented separately in temperature controlled stainless steel vats at 23 °C. An intense ruby red colour. Vinous and clean aroma's with hints of red berry fruits. Round in the mouth and medium bodied. A well-rounded finish with mellow tannin.

### ALOE TREE SHIRAZ WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

Hedgerow fruit followed up with a nice little amount of spice from start to finish. Berries with a touch of pepper. Great for charcuterie boards or for an easy drinking glass for those who want more than just fruit. The iconic Aloe Tree image is sure to be familiar to anyone who has travelled widely through the Cape and is an important part of the biodiversity which South Africa is famous for.

### PALAZZO DEL MARE ROSSO SICILY

Palazzo del Mare's vineyard sites are situated at an altitude of 200-300m, ensuring cooler night time temperatures which preserve crucial acidity in the grapes. Ample ripe, plummy fruit, hints of spice and liquorice, red and cherry fruits, this wine is deliciously supple and juicy.

### CIELO 'TERRE ALEGRA' SANGIOVESE VENETO, ITALY

A fourth generation family estate winery established in 1908 that focuses on reflecting the special bond with the earth (terra). This is a very seductive wine with ripe, luscious berries on the palate. It's so smooth and works particularly well with roasted red meats.

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## VIÑAMAR SAUVIGNON BLANC CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

From the cool climate of the Casablanca Valley, Vinamar wines are crafted by gifted young winemaker, Francesca Perazzo. The cool nights mean that grapes ripen perfectly and arrive at the winery in pristine condition ready to be transformed into these fantastic easy drinking styles. Intensely aromatic Chilean Sauvignon Blanc, following up herbal notes with a rounded, tropical flavour of pineapple and mango.

## PIERRE ET PAPA WHITE IGP COMTÉ TOLOSAN , FRANCE

Inspired by the fanciful tales of Pierre Renard and his father, Pierre et Papa's nostalgic feel is very much in tune with the desire to seek out honest value. From approximately 20 year old vines from vines planted at around 4,000 vines per ha on selected plots on clay and limestone soils in the area of Comté Tolosan around Toulouse in Gascony. This area benefits hugely from the influence of the Atlantic; Crisp and lively with an abundance of peach, honey, apple and tangy citrus fruit on the palate.

## CENTELLEO AIREN | MOSCATEL LA MANCHA, SPAIN

Centelleo wines are made entirely from free run juice and fermented in temperature controlled, stainless steel tanks and then matured on fine lees until bottling. The Moscatel brings some honey to the nose, while white floral notes and lime linger on the palate with a nice dry finish.

## ALOE TREE CHENIN BLANC WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

Aromatic guava and orange blossom jump from the glass – this Chenin Blanc is dry with hint of sweetness from the ripe apples, peaches and a hint of orange peel on the palate. The elegant crisp finish makes this a fantastic wine for all occasions.

## LAS CONDES CHARDONNAY CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

Las Condes is from Viña Santa Carolina, which was founded in 1922 in Santiago, and is one of the oldest wine producers in Chile. Hannah imports this wine range directly from Chile with Hayward Bros and it's a great example of how quality wine can reach your glass for a great price. Las Condes Chardonnay has a fruity nose with a smokiness and fresh pineapple and banana fruit. On the palate the tropical fruit is met by a smooth, creamy mouth-feel and balancing acidity.

## PALAZZO DEL MARE CATARRATTO IGT SICILY

Harvested in the cool of the morning for maximum preservation of fresh fruit flavours. A riot of tropical peach and pineapple aromas leap out of the glass. These flavours continue onto the palate joined by lovely ripe pear and a lick of acidity to balance the ripe fruit.

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### AI GALERA 'ENCANTADO' ROSÉ TEJO, PORTUGAL

Made from 100% Tinta Roriz; one of the grapes used in Port. Darker in colour this wine packs a punch with deep and richer flavours. It still has fresh, fruity dry delicate top layers though. A real surprise when we found this wine. A great little food rosé.

## VIÑA REQUINGUA 'ARTE NOBLE' PINOT NOIR CURICO VALLEY, CHILE

Santiago Achurra Larrain founded the winery in 1961 and alongside new generations of his family, has grown the winery to be amongst Chile's top 20 producers. Rich red berry and strawberry fruit with some warming spice flavours which include cinnamon and cloves; beautiful balance, juicy and smoky with a lingering finish.

## EL PRIMERO GRACIANO | GARNACHA DO NAVARRA, SPAIN

Following the age old tradition of offering weary pilgrims on the Camino de Santiago a taste of the fresh new vintage wines, El Primero offers weary wine drinkers a taste of all that is good in modern Spain. The wine is bright, full of succulent fruit and a wonderfully perfumed example of a Graciano Garnacha blend.

## BOCCANTINO ORGANIC NEGROAMARO SALENTO, ITALY

Founded in 1952 and based in Trentino, Alto Adige, Schenk Italian Wineries is one of the leading wine producers and exporters of Italian wines. Two flying winemakers, five oenologists and highly trained staff look after the production process. This organic Negroamaro shows and intense nose of blackberry and plum notes. On the palate, is it rounded, well-balanced, with a persistent and long finish. A delicious and natural taste of Italy!

## CEPAS MALBEC MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

Because of the popularity of Argentine Malbec, it can sometimes prove difficult to find a memorable wine. Cepas Malbec stands out from the crowd and offers all the tasty traits we demand of an Argentine Malbec... and some. Ripe plummy tannins, hints of sweet spice such as vanilla and cinnamon, gnarly hedgerow fruit. It's too delicious not to remember!

## SCHENK WINERY 'GERGENTI' FRAPPATO TERRE SICILIAN VINO BIOLOGICO SICILY

This Gergenti Organic Frappato, made by organically grown grapes, embodies the unique charm of Sicily. Fresh, fruity and like a bowl full of blueberries and blackberries. A wine that is shown TLC from start to finish - completely hand harvested, sustainable produced and organically grown. It's a juicy taste of Sicily in one glass!

## MAISON SINNAE 'ELEMENTS TERRA' CÔTES DU RHÔNE RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE

Situated on the right bank of the Rhône, Maison Sinnae grew up on the plateau dominating the villages of Laudun and Chusclan. It was there that the Romans began to spread the culture of vines and wine over two thousand years ago: at Caesar's Camp. This wine is rich in aromas of ripe red berries which gives a full-bodied wine that promises pure indulgence on the palate. Great with lamb, curries and casseroles.

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## SNAPPER ROCK PINOT GRIS MARLBOROUGH, N.ZEALAND

Such a fruity and vibrant wine: pear, tropical notes and packed full of stone fruit. This bottle really does show that there is more to Marlborough NZ than Savvy B! It's a great wine for this time of year and would work so well at a BBQ.

## TE QUIERO ORGANIC FIELD BLEND WHITE LA MANCHA, SPAIN

A tantalising taste of contemporary Spain in a glass. Much of Spain's vineyards are devoted to the commercial grape varieties that we all know and love such, but there are also small plots of older, native varieties that farmers have preserved out of a sense of pride or interest in their history to bring together lots of things that we love about Spain, from the dry grown bush vines seemingly being watered by magic, amongst the abundant saffron croci that are common across La Mancha. This field blend is a celebration of older varieties which are diverse and native. Flavoursome and vibrant - delicious!

## KOPKE DOURO WHITE DOURO VALLEY, PORTUGAL

From the steep banks of the Douro and from plots between 300 and 600 metres high, the Douro White from Kopke, Portugal's oldest port house, is a still white that makes a delightful entrance to your wine glass. Made from a blend of indigenous grapes: Arinto, Gouveio and Rabigato, this really is everything that is great about still wines from Portugal - aromatic, mineral, excellent acidity and a long, seductive finish.

## SCHENK WINERY 'GERGENTI' GRILLO TERRE SICILIAN VINO BIOLOGICO SICILY

Gergenti Organic Grillo embodies the unique charm of Sicily. It's a fresh and fruity wine that bursts with Sicilian citrus. Very bright and clean drinking experience on the palate with a delicious acidity. Perfect with pasta, fish or grilled veggies, but we adore it as an aperitif!

## PASSAGE DU SUD VERMENTINO S.FRANCE

Bright lemon in the glass. Blending floral notes on the nose, with fresh pear, lime, green apple. A full-bodied white, creamy in texture and vibrant. Ample acidity in the lingering finish. Enjoy it chilled as an aperitif or with chicken & avocado salad or classic fish & chips

## DOMAINE DE LA NÖE MUSCADET SUR LIE LOIRE, FRANCE

Muscadet really is a fresh drinking style of wine. Pale yellow with golden nuances, it reveals white and citrus fruit flavours and a hint of hazelnut. Fruity, fine, elegant, slightly fizzy and an aromatic finish. An excellent accompaniment to fish dishes

## CAPE TOWN WINE CO. CABERNET SAUVIGNON | MERLOT | CABERNET FRANC CAPE TOWN, SOUTH AFRICA

The Cape Town 'appellation' - incorporating wards such as Constantia, Durbanville, Philadelphia and Hout Bay - might only be a few years old but it speaks to a much older legacy. It is Cape Town of course where the South African winelands began. Cape Town Wine Co pays homage to the city's crucial role in establishing the Cape winelands. A new world take on an old school Bordeaux, full yet smooth – we love it!

## DOMAINE AURIOL GABARON ORGANIC FAUGÈRES LEZIGNAN-CORBIÈRES, FRANCE

An organic blend of 50% Grenache, 30% Mourvèdre and 20% Syrah. We love rustic French Faugeres wines that offer something complex and almost chewy to ponder on the palate. Deep red, complex, compelling nose showing aromas of black fruits, candied liquorice, coffee and sweet spices. Rounded and full-bodied on the palate.

## CAVE DE LA COTE PINOT NOIR SWITZERLAND

Decant this wine a little while before drinking as it can be a bit 'closed' initially and will appreciate time to open up to its full potential. When it has had the chance to breathe you will pour a light ruby wine into your glass with aromas of redcurrant, raspberry and a hint of strawberry with a nice smokiness. On the palate, the red fruits come through again. The tannins are not too harsh or overwhelming and there is a fresh acidity. A silky, smooth Swiss Pinot that oozes class.

## DOMAINE MATRAY JULIÉNAS BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE

Hannah claims this as being ;the best Julié纳斯 she has tried in the last 20 years!' A more refined nose than many Beaujolais Cru, bursting with mixed red and black berry fruits and some tantalising spice. A delicious tannic quality plays in the mouth. A very classy wine with a female winemaker at the helm.

## VIÑEDO DE LOS VIENTOS 'NOTOS' NEBBIOLO ATLÁNTIDA, URUGUAY

*Viñedo de los Vientos*' translates into "*Vineyard of the Winds*" and is located where the river Plate estuary and the Atlantic Ocean meet, providing clean cool ocean breezes and an ideal climate for the maturation of fine wine grapes. Very typical cherry red colour; clean floral notes, dried rose petals, warming spice. Medium bodied with cherry and raspberry fruit, some spice and well-structured tannins. Hannah's current favourite red!

## CHÂTEAU MAYNE MAZEROLLES BLAYE, CÔTES DE BORDEAUX

Merlot 80%, Cabernet Sauvignon 10%, Malbec 10% An elegant, black fruited wine with discreet notes of spicy, vanilla oak and wild sage. Opulent and textured with fine, smooth tannins and blackberry flavours that linger on the persistent finish.

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## DOMAINE DE LA CREUZE NOIRE MÂCON-FUISSÉ 'LES CHATAIGNIERS' BURGUNDY, FRANCE

From a fifth generation, family-owned winery that is located on the Maçon/Beaujolais A small producer, who avoids chemical insecticides, and cares about sustainability. More elegance and flavour than an 'entry level' Maçon Villages offers you. This is a fresh little number, with bright tropical notes, a soft and rounded toasty background and clean citrus notes to support. A clean drinking Chardonnay from a classic region, made by producers who all the critics are started to notice.

## WEINHOF WALDSHÜTZ KAMPTAL GRÜNER VELTLINER KAMPTAL, AUSTRIA

This Grüner Veltliner is produced in the Kamptal wine region – one of the most interesting wine regions in Austria, whose name is derived from the River Kamp. Weinhof Waldshütz say it best themselves: 'the soil carries its history into the wine cellar... the mineral spice of the primary rock, with the fine fruit and fragrant nuances of the loess soil'. For us, it's a fresh, crisp, mineral Grüner, that feels like you're drinking from a natural spring – of wine! Delicious.

## PRODUTTORI DE MANDURIA 'ALICE' VERDECA MANDURIA PUGLIA, ITALY

Meet ALICE: She's fresh, vibrant, crisp, with some salty vibes that pair beautifully with lemon/acidity. Lovely wine chilled down and enjoyed in the garden with a spot of sunshine, but she absolutely SINGS with fish! Little fact: Although we pronounce her Alice, as 'in Wonderland', it's actually the Italian word for anchovies - hence the funky packaging!

## VIÑEDO DE LOS VIENTOS 'ESTIVAL' ATLÁNTIDA, URUGUAY

60% Gewurztraminer, 30% Chardonnay & 10% Moscato Bianco. Passion fruit, pineapple skins and floral notes abound on the nose; there are some hints of citrus on the palate which is unctuous but offers a savouring acidity and impeccable balance. A stand out wine from Uruguay made in small quantities!

## WEINGUT GÜNTER & REGINA TRIEBAUMER DRY FURMINT AUSTRIA

Weingut Günter & Regina Triebaumer dry Furmint is bright, fresh and aromatic – think ripe Williams pears, juicy pineapple and a bouquet of white blossom on the nose and palate. An interesting grape from a region that is a little different to the norm (Hungary)

## VIÑA COBOS 'FELINO' CHARDONNAY MENDOZA, ARGENTINA

An award-winning winery in the heart of Mendoza with Paul Hobbs at the helm. They are meticulous in the approach to winemaking and are all about the 'science of wine' with cutting edge studies into terroir and production. Felino Chardonnay really is nectar in a glass; elegant & balanced, hints of tropical fruits and brioche, unoaked and very clean drinking.
