LAS CONDES MERLOT CENTRAL VALLEY, CHILE

Hannah has a long relationship with this winery and has been directly importing it for years. A great little party wine which is full of fruit, but not too jammy, juicy plums and a subtle finish of spice. The ultimate easy drinking BBQ red wine that doesn't break the bank.

CASTILLO DEL MORO TEMPRANILLO | SYRAH SPAIN

Literally meaning 'the most wanted', Vinos Más Buscados is a collection of wines grown and nurtured in the Southern half of Spain, mainly in the area known as La Mancha — a region undergoing a serious 'makeover' over the last few years. Ruby red colour with violet tints showing its youth. On the nose, it is fresh and elegant with characteristic aromas of cherry and red fruits typical of this variety. Light, harmonic and round on the palate with soft tannins.

AI GALERA 'POETICO' PORTUGAL

CASTELÃO 40% | TRINCADEIRA 40% | TINTA MIÚDA 20%

Long overlooked by the wine cognoscenti, the burgeoning interest in Portuguese wine is finally resulting in more awareness of the potential of this proud country. The previously undervalued Tejo region, lying to the south of Lisbon, can produce wines of enormous value and character — something that is captured by Ai Galera. Each variety is fermented separately in temperature controlled stainless steel vats at 23 °C. An intense ruby red colour. Vinous and clean aromas with hints of red berry fruits. Round in the mouth and medium bodied. A well-rounded finish with mellow tannin.

ALOE TREE SHIRAZ WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

Hedgerow fruit followed up with a nice little amount of spice from start to finish. Berries with a touch of pepper. Great for charcuterie boards or for an easy drinking glass for those who want more than just fruit. The iconic Aloe Tree image is sure to be familiar to anyone who has travelled widely through the Cape and is an important part of the biodiversity which South Africa is famous for.

PALAZZO DEL MARE ROSSO SICILY

Palazzo del Mare's vineyard sites are situated at an altitude of 200-300m, ensuring cooler night-time temperatures which preserve crucial acidity in the grapes. Ample ripe, plummy fruit, hints of spice and liquorice, red and cherry fruits, this wine is deliciously supple and juicy.

CIELO 'TERRE ALEGRA' SANGIOVESE VENETO, ITALY

A fourth-generation family estate winery established in 1908 that focuses on reflecting the special bond with the earth (terra). This is a very seductive wine with ripe, luscious berries on the palate. It's so smooth and works particularly well with roasted red meats.
