CA' TESORE – SANGIOVESE – ITALY

Bright crimson in colour, with a bouquet of mature fruits – cherry and prune and dried herbs. It's rich, fruity and smooth..

LA PINADA – 2020 BOBAL AGRICOLA DE VINOS LA HIGUERA

Chisco sources the grapes for this joyous little number from a single parcel called La Pinada planted in Spain in 1958, growing on alluvial and clay soils. This is all about fresh fruit, with lovely crunchy acidity and a slightly darker spine of fruit lurking underneath to add interest.

COMMISSIONER'S BLOCK – SHIRAZ – AUSTRALIA

Alive with blackberry, raspberry and vanilla with a hint of roasted coffee bean. There's concentrated dark plum and spicy pepper flavours shaped by lively tannins. It's a great wine now, but a few more interesting things will develop with another 2-4 years quietly hidden away.

COQUILLE DE TERRE – CARIGNAN VIEILLES VIGNES

A fresh lively Languedoc wine with soft, ripe tannins. It's deliciously fruity with aromas of dried cranberries and raspberries, in addition to a light touch of tobacco and spiced nuts.

LE PROFESSEUR – MARSELAN – PAYS D'OC

This unique indigenous grape is a cross between Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache named after Paul Truel who invented it in 1961. Dark and intense with purple hues of blackberry and cassis with a hint of violet and black pepper.

ELABORATION G.S.M GRENACHE | SYRAH | MOURVEDRE

A harmonious fusion of fruit, spice, tannins and structure. Juicy berry flavours and alluring aromas of sweet spices. A perfect Autumn red to enjoy with a Beef Bourguignon perhaps.
